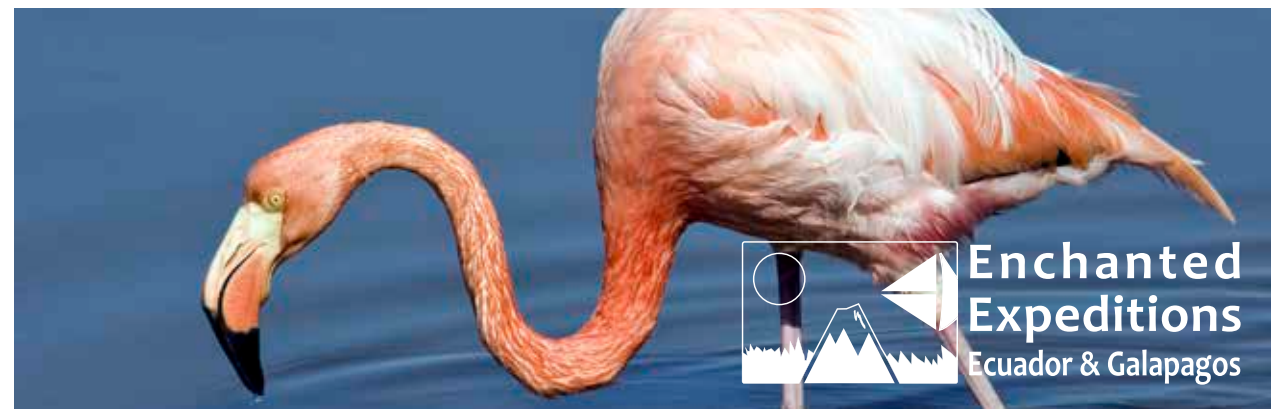

Because the Cachalote Explorer is spacious and comfortable our passengers are able to spend more time relaxing and admiring the scenery.

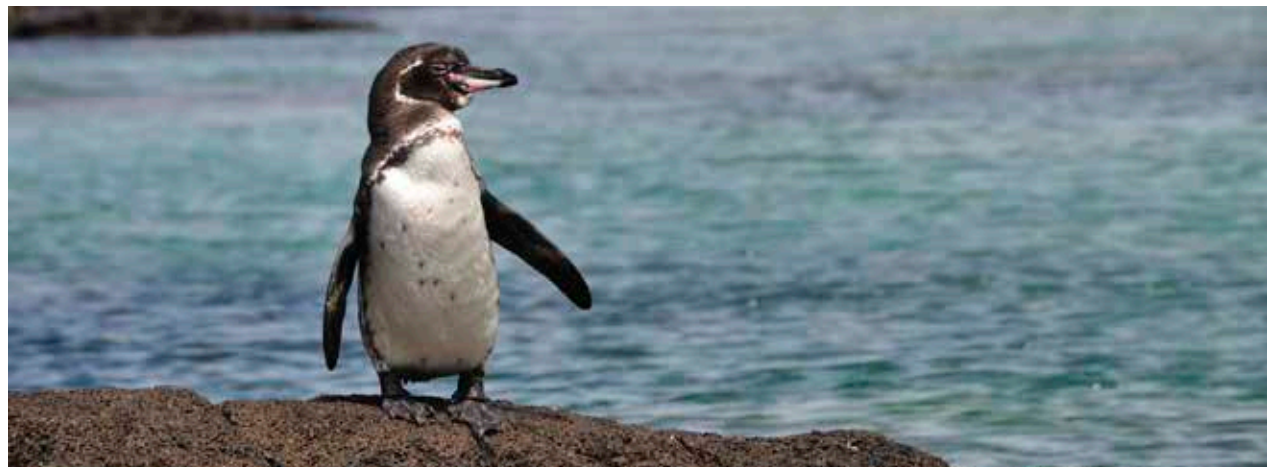


A TYPICAL DAY AS AN EXPLORER

After lunch the boat moves to a new visitor site. During this time guests have the opportunity to rest and look for marine life from one of the decks.

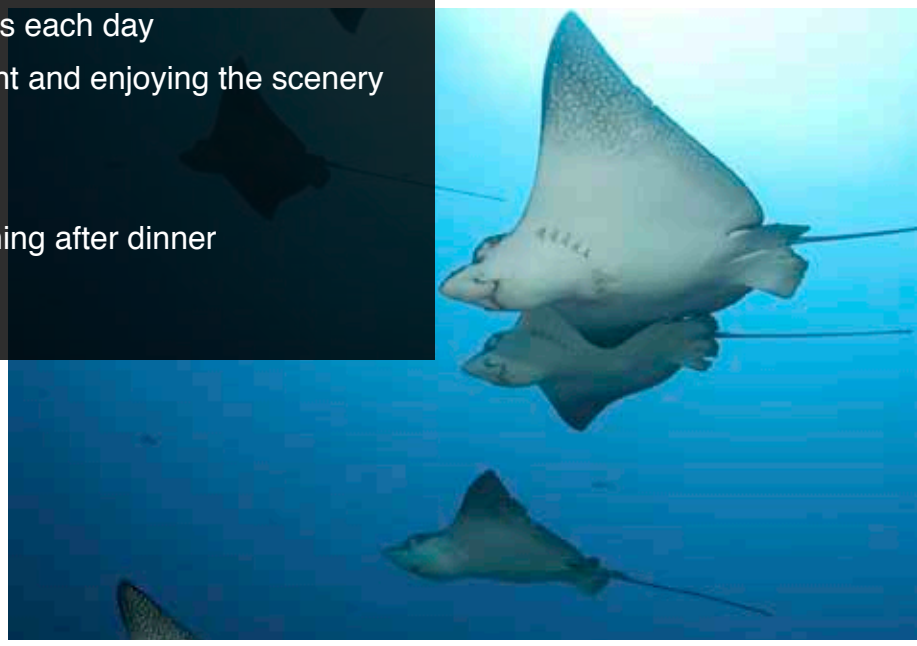
Later in the afternoon passengers disembark for another nature walk, and perhaps another opportunity to snorkel and swim.

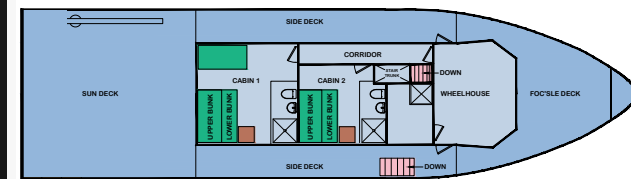

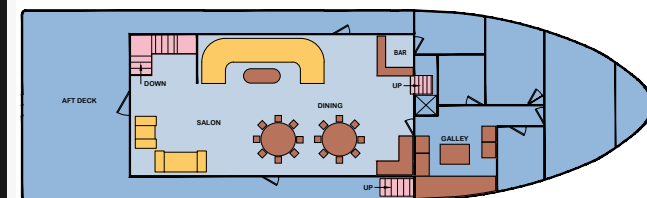

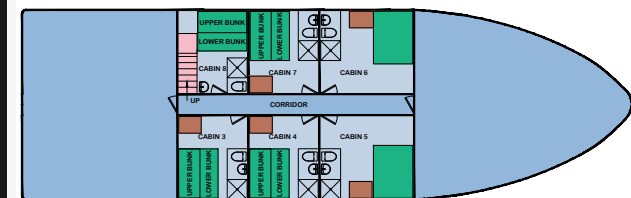
UPPER DECK
